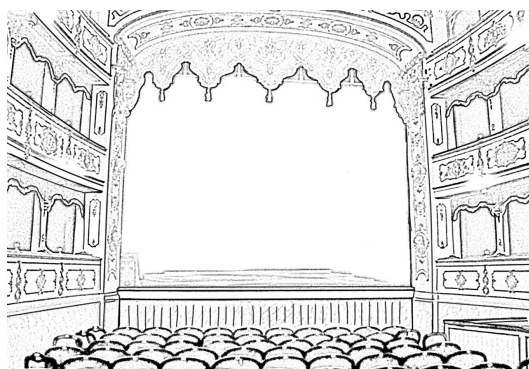

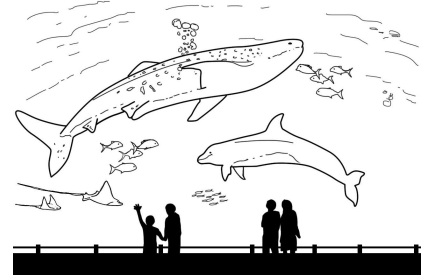

Follow these steps:

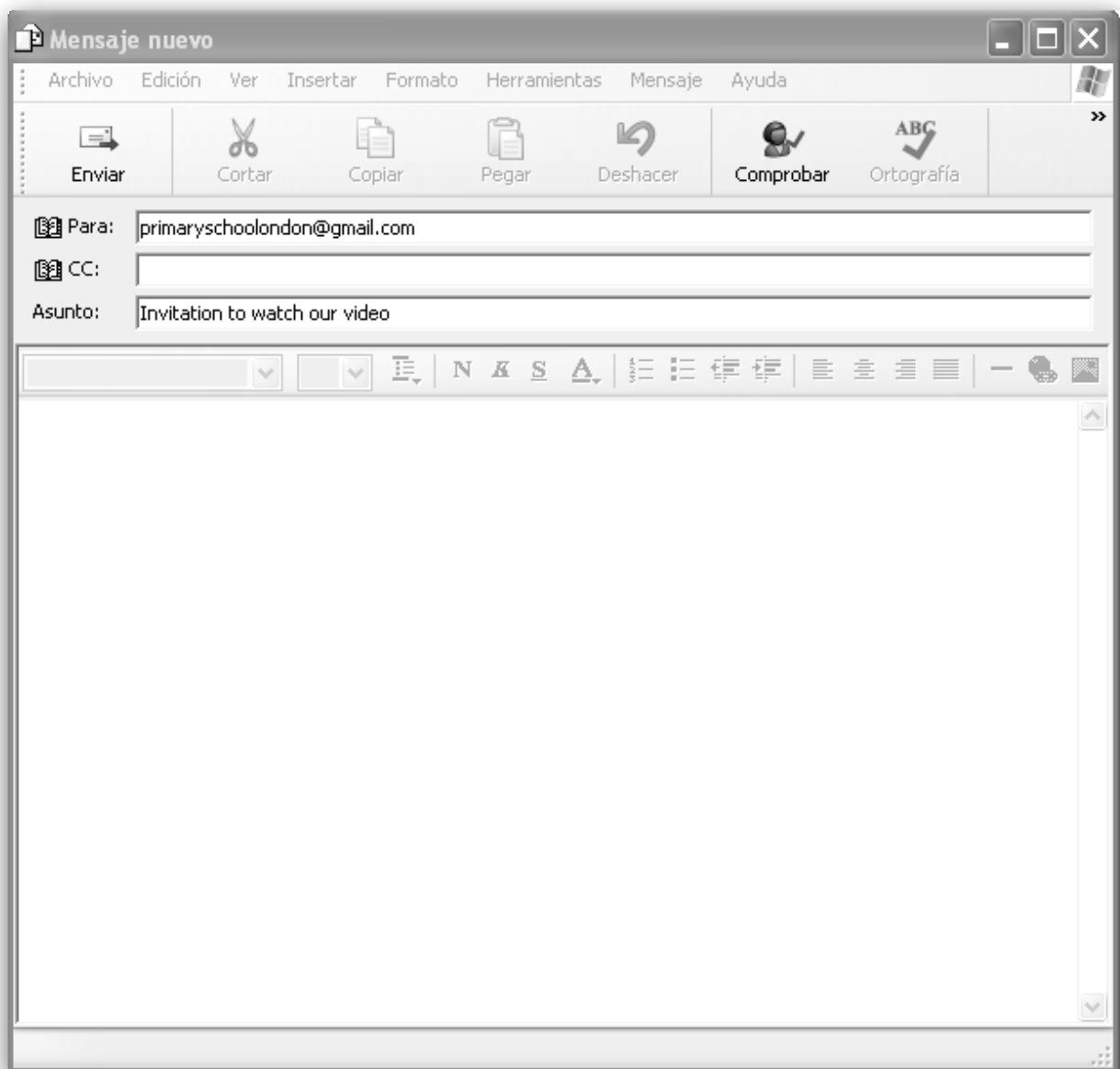
1st: Greet your new friend.
