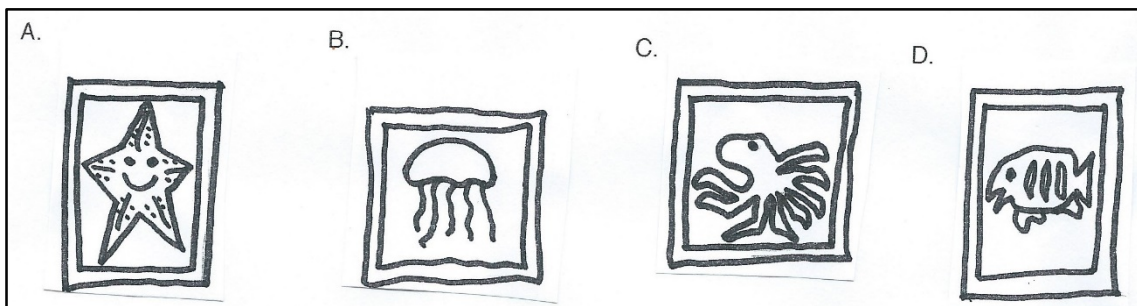

TEXT 2. THE SEASONS

There are four seasons in a year: spring, summer, autumn and winter. The Earth spins around the Sun and the seasons change.

In **spring**, everything is green. Trees begin to grow their leaves and plants start to flower. Birds sing and many animals have their babies in spring. It is warm and sometimes it is rainy. Children can fly kites and ride bikes.



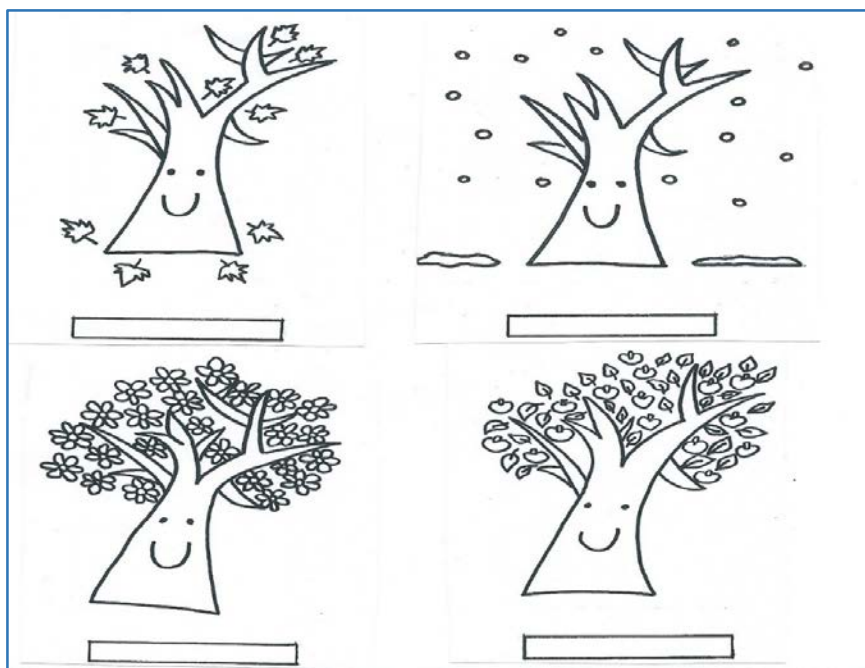
In **summer**, the Sun shines and it is hot. Fruit grows on trees and plants. Days are long and nights are short. We wear shorts, sunglasses and sandals. Children can play outside, eat ice cream and watermelon, go to the beach or swim in pools.

In **autumn**, leaves change colour and fall from the trees. Some animals collect food before winter comes. The weather is rainy and windy and the air is cool. Autumn is called fall in the United States.

In **winter**, trees don't have leaves. It is cold and sometimes it is snowy. Some animals, like bats or bears, find places to hide and sleep. This is called *hibernation*. Days are short and nights are long. We wear gloves, scarves and woolen hats. Children can make snowmen, ice skate or ski.

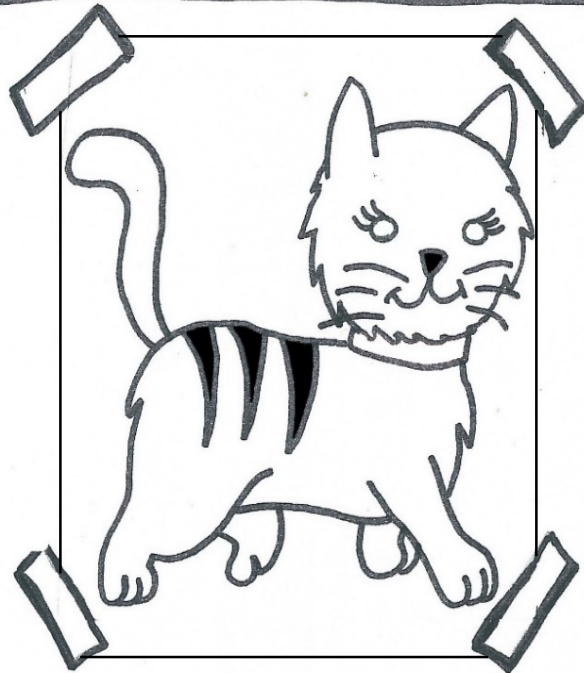
