	<p>The Moon is a satellite that goes around the Earth. It takes 28 days for the Moon to go around the Earth. The Moon is about 320.000 kilometres from the Earth. It is about $\frac{1}{4}$ the size of the Earth. That means the Earth is four times larger than the Moon.</p>






