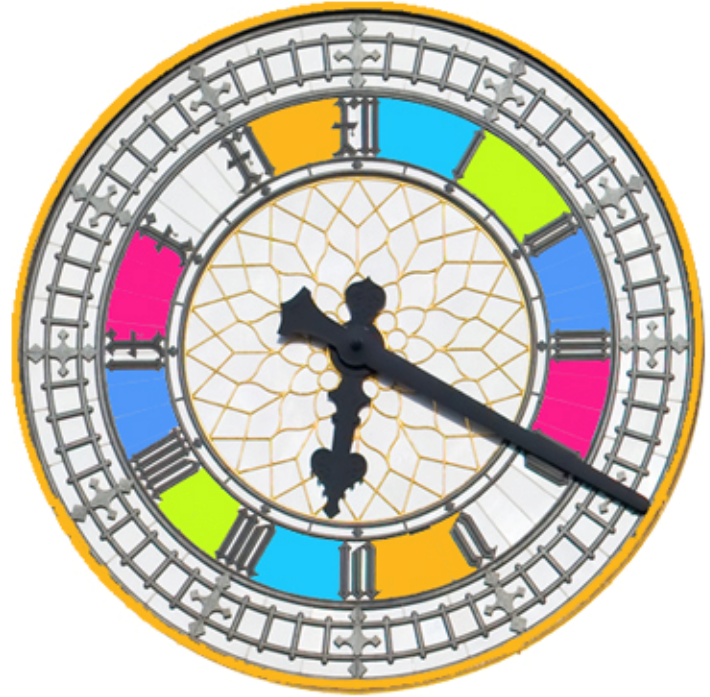

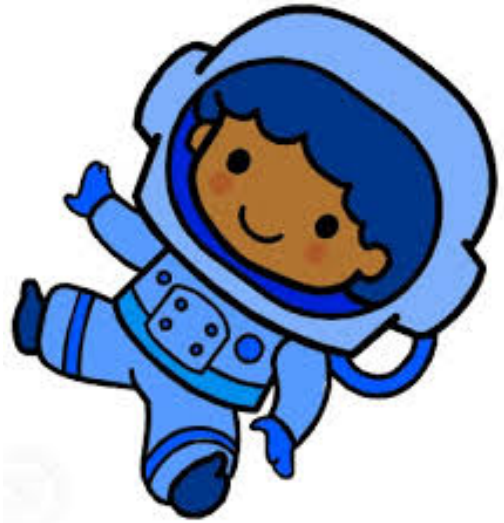

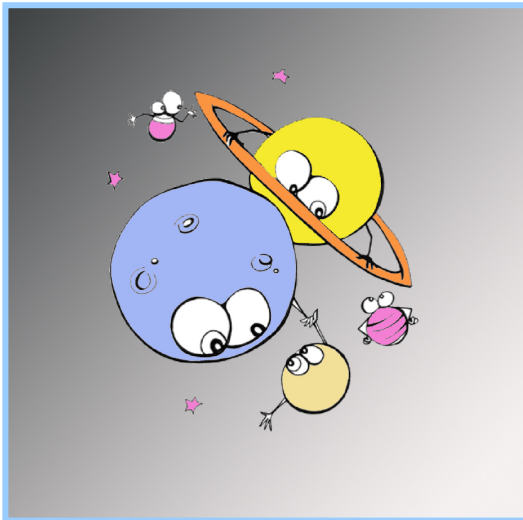

Saprunion, the Sunflower planet

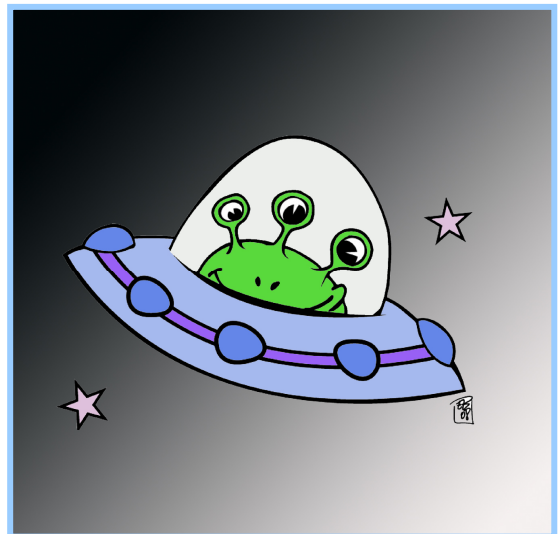


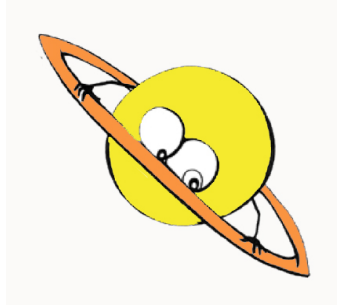
The Zorg galaxy is about 200 million kilometers from the Earth. In this galaxy there is a planet called Saprunion, which is the eighth planet in its system.

Saprunion is a giant planet, made of gas. These gases make it look yellow. It has got 5 orange rings around it, like Saturn. The planet is also known as the Sunflower planet because of these colours.

There are 7 moons orbiting Saprunion: Sap is the biggest one and Ion is the smallest. A day in Saprunion is 32 hours long and it takes 70 months to go around its sun.

The weather is very bad: it's windy, stormy, and it's freezing cold. You can't survive in Saprunion because there is no oxygen. Saprunion has got a huge ocean of salty water but no animals live in it.

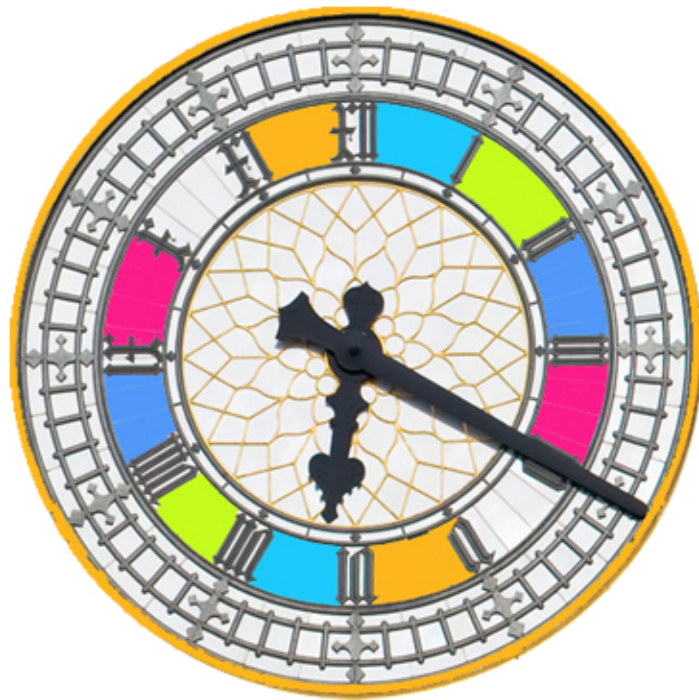

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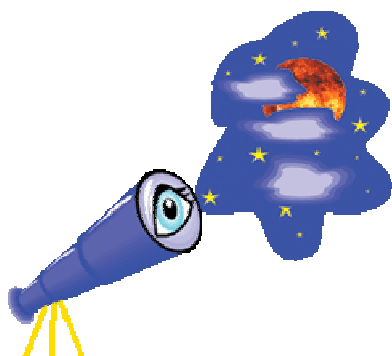
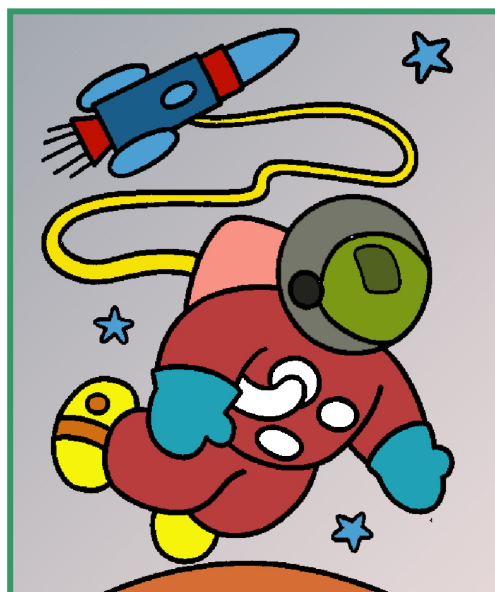
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I want to be an astronaut!

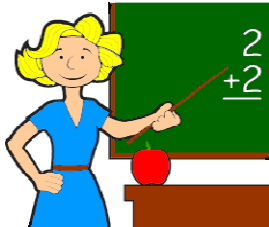

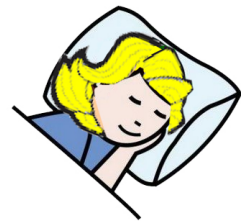
